Dear FPPC Commissioners,

At the FPPC meeting in August you agreed to set aside the consideration of a stipulation reached with the College of the Canyons Foundation until the October meeting.

I am asking you extend that period until a date to be determined in the future for the following reasons.

First, I am attempting to independently determine the source of the contribution (\$150,000) using the Richard McKee Act to obtain financial documents that assure me that the funds came from non-donor sources. The Foundation is indicates that the Response to the request cannot be provided until November 19, well after the date you scheduled to rehear the stipulation.

Second, after your August meeting I received a copy of the Form 461 completed in 2019 and signed by Foundation head Cathy Ritz indicating that

"Contributions made from revenue received in exchange for exclusive distribution or management rights on campus".

I filed a public records for copies of the contracts behind the distribution rights and was advised that the Foundation does not have any responsive documents.

Third, there is an open FPPC investigation against the College of the Canyons (COM-06052019-01088) and it is my opinion after listening to the August meeting that these cases should be heard together for any settlement stipulation. There appears to be an important nexus between the Public Agency employees and those at the Foundation.

My impression is that you were not aware of the open investigation of the college at the August meeting. FPPC staff did not mention this fact.

In the interest of fairness I bring these facts to your attention for consideration.

I am planning to give public comment at the September meeting, and I wanted to provide this statement for your benefit in advance of the meeting.



This letter is in response to your Public Records Act request submitted to me via email on July 29, 2020. This will serve as the College of the Canyons Foundation's ("Foundation") response to your request. As an auxiliary organization, the Foundation is not subject to California's Public Records Act. However, its records are subject to disclosure under the comparable Richard McKee Transparency Act. We provide this response in accordance with the McKee Transparency Act.

The McKee Transparency Act is a transparency statue specific to community college district auxiliary organizations and recognizes them as legally separate from the California Community Colleges. (See, Ed. Code, § 72690.) However, in accordance with one of its provisions (Ed. Code, § 72695), any document that is exempt under the PRA is also exempt from disclosure under the McKee Act. (Ed. Code, § 72695, Gov. Code, §§ 6254, et seq.)

Under the McKee Transparency Act, the Foundation is required to make public records available for inspection, or to permit you to obtain copies, unless the record is subject to an exemption. Public records are "any writing containing information relating to the conduct of the public's business prepared, owned, used, or retained by any state or local agency." (Ed. Code, § 72695; Gov. 





The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission received the enclosed complaint, COM-06052019-01088, on 6/5/2019 12:59:00 PM. The information filed in the complaint is below and any attachments filed will be included.

The Complaint was formally filed against:

College of the Canyons Respondent

The Violations alleged are:

Laundered Campaign Contributions

Contributions by Intermediary or Agent (84302)

Based upon information obtained through a Public Records Request with the FPPC, it is believed that College of the Canyons (a public agency) used public resource in the form of staff time, reputation, and goodwill to secure a short term lease for the Committee for College of the Canyons-Yes on Measure E Committee ID 1384666 at the Westfield Valencia Mall. The Treasurer Robert McCarty listed the contributor as Westfield Valencia Town Center. The true identity of the contributor was not Westfield, but the College of the Canyons. The College of the Canyons acted as an intermediary by allowing the Committee to conduct campaigns activity from the location (Suite2312) in the Valencia Town Center Mall.

In preparing this complaint I have relied upon guidance provided in Campaign Manual 3 (August 2018) Chapter 4.1 A (Restriction on Contributions).

"Campaign reports are often the only means for the press and the public to determine who is supporting or opposing a ballot measure." and Quick Tip "Concealing the true identity of a donor is a serious violation"

It is particularly offensive, and perhaps criminal that the intermediary is a public agency, identified as College of the Canyons that stood to benefit when the bond measure was passed.
