On October 7, 2017, Governor Brown signed AB 249 (the Disclose Act) into law. The substantive provisions of the bill go into effect on January 1, 2018. The Disclose Act significantly changed various provisions in the Act. FPPC staff has begun implementing the legislation and

efforts will continue in the coming months. Below is a summary of the implementation plan for AB 249.
