# FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of this item will not result in the use of additional Discretionary General Funding (Net County Cost). Adequate appropriation and revenue have been included in the County Administrative Office's 2016-17 budget (AAA CAO), and will be included in future recommended budgets.

# BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The proposed agreement will provide for the California Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) to enforce the Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance for the period of January 1, 2017, through December 31, 2018. The proposed agreement has essentially the same terms as those of the County's current agreement with the FPPC, which expires December 31, 2016. The recommended agreement will continue these services for an additional two years.

On August 28, 2012 (Item 45), the Board adopted the Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance (adding sections 12.4301 through 12.4318 to the County Code) which established a campaign contribution limit for all candidates for elected County offices and certain other related requirements. The contribution limit was based on the contribution limit set forth in the Political Reform Act. The adjusted contribution limit under the Political Reform Act for 2017-2018 is \$4,400. Government Code section 83123.5 (derived from Assembly Bill No. 2146, sponsored by

# STATE OF CALIFORNIA FAIR POLITICAL PRACTICES COMMISSION AND

# COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO CAMPAIGN LAW ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered into this 30th day of November 2016, by and between the State of California, acting by and through the Fair Political Practices Commission, (hereinafter referred to as the "FPPC") and the County of San Bernardino (hereinafter referred to as the "County").

WHEREAS, the County has determined that it is in the best interest of the County to retain the services of the FPPC to provide for the enforcement and interpretation of campaign laws under the provisions of the County of San Bernardino Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance.

WHEREAS, the FPPC has the special skills, knowledge, experience, and expertise in the area of the enforcement and interpretation of campaign laws necessary to effectively advise, assist, litigate, and otherwise represent the County on such matters.

WHEREAS, the FPPC is agreeable to providing for the enforcement and interpretation of campaign laws under the provision of the County of San Bernardino Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance.

WHEREAS, the FPPC's enforcement and interpretation of campaign laws under the provisions of the County of San Bernardino Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance is expressly authorized by California Government Code Section 83123.5.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The FPPC agrees to provide the County campaign law enforcement and interpretation services for the impartial, effective administration, implementation, and enforcement of the County of San Bernardino Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance as dictated in paragraph 2.
- 2. Campaign Law Enforcement Services.

# A. Auditing

The FPPC agrees to audit each candidate and his or her controlled committee for elective County office for whom it is determined that \$2,000 or more in contributions have been received or \$2,000 in expenditures have been made, whether by the candidate or a committee or committees controlled by the candidate or primarily supporting his or her candidacy. Audit periods will be determined by the FPPC to ensure comprehensive audit findings.

#### B. Enforcement

The FPPC agrees to serve as the civil and administrative prosecutor for violations of the San Bernardino Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance. The FPPC, at its sole discretion, may investigate possible violations and may commence civil and administrative actions in accordance with Title 9 of the Government Code and Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.

#### C. Consultation

The FPPC may, in its sole discretion, provide written assistance to candidates for elected County offices and potential contributors in a County election regarding the provisions of the County of San Bernardino Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance upon the request of the candidate or potential contributor.

- 3. The term of this Agreement is January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2018. Services shall commence on the beginning of this term. Services from prior contracts shall continue as previously determined.
- 4. The County agrees to provide the FPPC with a resolution, motion, order, or ordinance of the governing body, which authorizes execution of this Agreement, and indicating the individual who is authorized to sign the Agreement on behalf of the County.
- 5. The Contract Coordinators for this Agreement shall be:

- 6. In consideration for the above services, the County agrees to pay to the FPPC the sum of \$55,000, due and payable at the beginning of each year of the contract term as the "floor" payment for services provided. The FPPC shall track hours of its employees at the rates provided in sections 7 and 8 below, and shall bill the County at such rates for the cost of any work exceeding the \$55,000 "floor."
- 7. Pursuant to section 6, in consideration for the above services in excess of the "floor" amount, the County agrees to reimburse the FPPC upon receipt of an itemized invoice. The hourly rates used will be those established by the California Attorney General's Office, pursuant to Government Code Section 11044, set forth in the State Administrative Bulletin 13-13. The cumulative hours provided below are for estimate purposes only. In

the event that the hourly rates established by the California Attorney General's Office increase, or state reimbursement rates are increased, the County agrees to pay the increased hourly rate. It is understood by both parties that no advance written notification is necessary prior to implementing the increased rates.

8. The following is an estimate of the cumulative hours and costs for the administration, implementation, and enforcement of the San Bernardino Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance during the term of this Agreement.

### E. Miscellaneous

The FPPC shall bill its actual costs for ordinary costs and expenses directly related to the services provided. Ordinary costs and expenses shall be limited to:

- 1. Court fees, including filing fees, judicial officer fees, deposition fees, transcript fees, and process serving fees.
- 2. Travel, lodging, and meals pursuant to state reimbursement rates as necessary for FPPC officers.

3. Telephone charges, postage, photocopying/document reproduction costs, and damage to property repaired or replaced at state expense.

The FPPC shall bill its actual costs for extraordinary costs and expenses only upon prior approval by the County Counsel. Extraordinary costs and expenses include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Fees for third-party consultants, investigators, and experts including their travel, lodging, and meals.
- 2. Travel, lodging, and meals for witnesses.

In no event shall the FPPC bill for non-reimbursable costs and expenses including but not limited to:

- 1. Rent, utilities, computer equipment (including Westlaw, Lexis, or other provided charges for legal research).
- 2. Charges for time spent to provide necessary information for monthly billing statements, State audits, or billing inquiries.
- 3. Charges for work performed for extraordinary costs and expenses not authorized by the County Counsel.
- 9. The FPPC shall provide quarterly billing statements for work performed under this contract. Initial authority is extended for \$100,000 of work (including the \$55,000 "floor" and up to \$45,000 of billed work) performed during the first year of the contract (date of full execution through December 31, 2015) and \$100,000 of work (including the \$55,000 "floor" and up to \$45,000 of billed work) performed during the second year of the contract (January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016). For each year of the contract, after \$100,000 is worked/billed, additional approval shall be required by the Chief Executive Officer of the County of San Bernardino for each \$50,000 of additional work billed.
- 10. Except for extraordinary costs and expenses, no advance notification is necessary for services provided within the initial authority for \$100,000 for each year of the contract. The total amount of this Agreement shall not exceed \$300,000. Services shall not be provided exceeding the original estimated hours or the total amount of this Agreement unless advance notification is provided and the additional costs are mutually agreed upon in writing. In the event this contract is canceled or is not renewed, the FPPC will provide an estimate of remaining hours necessary to complete audits already in progress to be billed at the hourly rate and the audits may be completed upon mutual agreement.
- 11. The FPPC shall provide the County with an itemized invoice detailing all FPPC costs for the administration, implementation, and enforcement of the San Bernardino Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance under this Agreement.

Quarterly itemized invoices will be submitted to:

The County agrees to pay the FPPC within thirty (30) days of the date of the invoice.

### 12. AUDIT

The County agrees that the State of California, including but not limited to, the Department of General Services, the Bureau of State Audits, or their designated representative, shall have the right to review and to copy all records and supporting documentation pertaining to the performance of this Agreement. The County agrees to maintain records and supporting documentation for possible audit for a minimum of three (3) years after final payment, unless a longer period of records retention is stipulated. The County agrees to allow the auditor(s) access to records and supporting documentation during normal business hours and to allow interviews of any employees who might reasonably have information related to the records. Furthermore, the County agrees that the State of California has the same right to audit records and interview staff in any subcontract related to the performance of this Agreement. (Government Code Section 8546.7.)

# 13. <u>DISPUTES</u>

Any dispute concerning a question of fact arising under the terms of this Agreement that is not disposed within a reasonable period of time (ten days) by the parties normally responsible for the administration of this Agreement shall be brought to the attention of the Contract Coordinators for joint resolution.

#### 14. INDEMNIFICATION

Pursuant to Government Code Section 895.4 and except as provided below, the County agrees to indemnify, defend (with counsel approved by the FPPC General Counsel), and hold harmless the FPPC and its authorized officers, employees, agents, and volunteers from any and all claims, actions, losses, damages, and liability arising out of the performance of this Agreement, or from the enforcement or interpretation of any provision of the San Bernardino Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance, from any cause whatsoever, including the acts, errors, or omissions of any person and for any costs or expenses incurred by the FPPC on account of any claim except where such indemnification is prohibited by law.

The FPPC shall indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the County and its authorized officers, employees, agency, and volunteers from any and all claims, actions, losses, damages, and liability arising from the FPPC's sole negligence or willful misconduct relating to obligations under this Agreement.

#### 15. **AMENDMENT**

This Agreement may be amended by written mutual consent of the parties.

#### 16. CANCELATION

This Agreement may by canceled by either party at any time. In the event this Agreement is canceled by the County, the County agrees to pay for all services previously rendered unless the services required the County's prior approval and the FPPC failed to receive the County's approval prior to the cancelation. In the event that this Agreement is canceled by the FPPC, the County agrees to pay for all services previously completed unless the serviced required the County's prior approval and the FPPC failed to receive the County's approval prior to cancelation.
