- 4 (a) A written advertisement, as defined in Section 84501, for which a disclosure
- 5 requirement has not been specifically addressed in Article 5 of Chapter 4 and related regulations
- 6 must display the disclosures required by Sections 84502, 84503, and 84506.5 with sufficient
- 7 <u>contrast that is easily readable by the average viewer and sufficient size that is easily readable by</u>

8 <u>the average viewer.</u>

- 9 (b) If the advertisement is of a size similar to the size of advertisements that are designed
- 10 to be individually distributed, such as the size of a mailer, flyer or doorhanger, the font shall be in
- 11 an Arial equivalent type with a type size of at least 10-point. Small items listed in Section
- 12 <u>84501(a)(2)(D) do not require disclosures.</u>
- 13 (c) If the advertisement is larger than advertisements designed to be individually
- 14 distributed, such as the size of a yard sign or billboard, the font size for each line of the
- 15 disclosures must be five percent of the height of the advertisement.
