

(Regulations of the Fair Political Practices Commission, Title 2, Division 6, California Code of Regulations.)

§ 18250. Street Address.

For purposes of the Act, “street address” means:

- (a) A real property's street name, building number, city, state, and zip code; or
- (b) The Army and Air Force Post Office (A.P.O.) or Fleet Post Office (F.P.) address assigned by the United States government to an individual or a dependent who resides with the individual when the individual is on government duty outside the United States and does not have a conventional street address.
