I hope this email finds you well. I am writing to provide comments and feedback regarding the proposed updates to Form 700 and related documents, which the Commission will consider at its November 21, 2024, meeting.

While I appreciate the updates to align with recent legislation, including AB 1170, I have concerns regarding the mandatory transition to electronic filing for certain filers starting January 1, 2025. Specifically, I would like to raise the issue that many filers currently use certified e-filing systems, such as Granicus' DisclosureDocs or Netfile, which were previously acceptable to the FPPC. The mandatory transition could pose challenges for those filers accustomed to these systems, and I would encourage the FPPC to consider exceptions or alternatives to minimize potential disruptions.
